

Barn — red, white trim

1. Already coloured.
2. Cut the thick black lines, fold the dashed ones. The white trim is printed, not cut.
3. Bend the four walls into a box, glue the end tab inside the first wall.
4. Fold the floor up under the back wall, glue its three tabs inside.
5. Fold the small tabs on the barn ends inward. Bend the roof to match its three folds and glue it to those tabs, hood end over the hay door.
6. Build the cupola the same way — its notches sit over the ridge. Paper cutter: grey lines to the paper edge are the long straight cuts; the wall-bottom cut STOPS where the floor joins the back wall. Tip: a paper clip or bobby pin holds a glued tab square while the glue dries.
