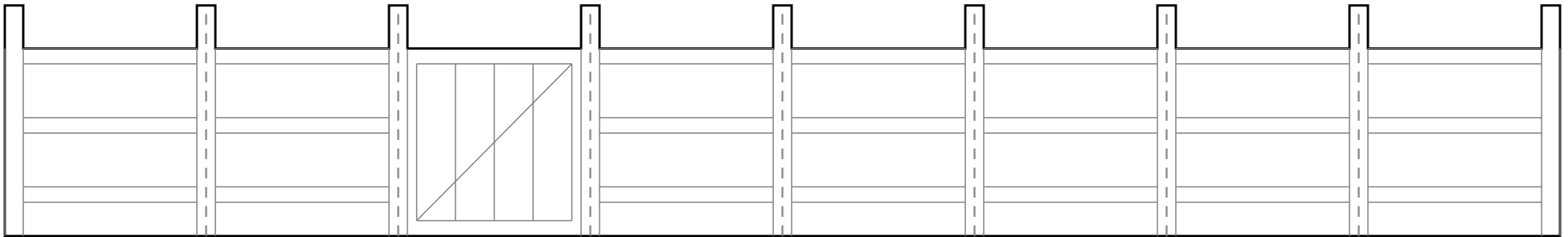
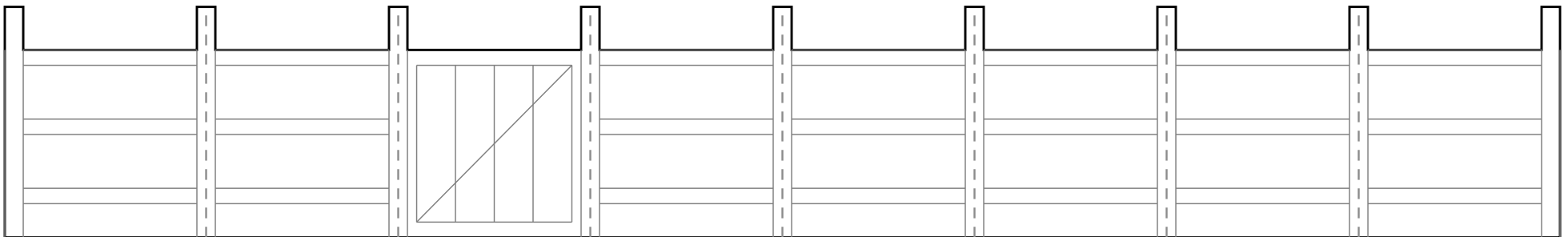


Fence — test model

1. Colour first. Posts and rails are the double grey lines.
 2. Cut round the thick black outline – the posts stand up above the top rail.
 3. Fold zig-zag on the dashed lines, one fold at each post, alternating in and out.
 4. Stand it up. No glue. Bend it tighter for a pen, straighter for a long run.
 5. Two strips glued end to end make one long fence. One panel is a gate.
- Tip: a paper clip or bobby pin holds a glued tab square while the glue dries.
